SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the HYC club house.

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be posted before 11:15am on Sunday.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the HYC flag pole. If a postponement is signaled ashore, a warning signal will be made not less than 45 minutes after flag AP is lowered.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

Rig from 10:00am to 11:00am

Skipper's Meeting at approximately 11:15am on the HYC deck

Warning Signal 11:30am or as soon as skipper's meeting is completed

Launch 11:35am or as soon as the ramp is usable

No warning signal will be made after 4:00pm to enable boats to haul out on the ramp

7 RACING AREAS

Attachment A shows the location of racing areas. If weather dictates, the Grub Tub line may be moved closer to the HYC dock, and/or the Laser line may be moved outside the harbor.

8 THE COURSES

11 THE START

Races will be started by using Appendix U, Audible-signal racing system.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

The penalties are as described in the RRS. For all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

16 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

Protests will be governed by the 5 minute rule on the water: 2 minutes for each party, 1 minute for the Race Committee. All protests must be settled before the start of the next race.

17 SCORING

The scoring system is as follows: Low Point System.

(a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

20 EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

Class sails are not required.

23 SUPPORT BOATS

HYC may offer spectator boats. Check the club bulletin board for more information.
